Dear Parent / Carer

I am writing to you regarding the latest Government guidance and how this will affect our Sixth Form students. Lessons will continue as they have done since September however, because guidance asks that we should not undertake non-essential travel we will be asking our students to stay on site during the day. From Thursday 2nd November, students should come into school for their first session of the day and not leave the premises until after their last lesson of the day, unless asked to remain by a member of staff for an extra session or meeting. This will be reviewed again on 2nd December when the national lockdown ends pending further guidance.

Students will need to have lunch on site and they have the option to bring their own lunch or order a school lunch. Food cannot be prepared or consumed in the Sixth Form block or the Turbine rooms. Students are able to eat their food in the upper school canteen which is based in the theatre, or on the outside picnic benches.

School lunches can be ordered through via their form register time or through Mr Myers on a Thursday for the following week. School lunches are now paid for through the MCAS app. Information about how to set up the app was sent out at the start of the school year.
