Here are the final arrangements for Airedale on Tour. This is one of the most exciting days in the year and we are really looking forward to it.

Lunch – If your child is eligible for free school meals and you have requested a packed lunch, this will be ready on the morning of the tour.

Pocket money – You may give your child a small amount of pocket money. They will be solely responsible for this.

Mobile phones – Exceptionally, these may be brought for Airedale on Tour.

Drinks – Please provide your child with a suitable drink. A refillable water bottle is ideal. No glass bottles or fizzy drinks please.

Departure and Return Times - Please ensure that students are in school in time for registration as indicated below. Return arrival times are approximate due to traffic conditions. If the return time is much later than published, we will text out. Please ensure that your child has safe passage home from school.

High standards of behaviour are paramount to the safety and enjoyment of all and as ever, we reserve the right to remove any students who do not show that. Final eligibility rests with our staff.

Whilst we do not expect students to wear school uniform on this day, we do have a dress code, which must be adhered to. Clothes which have offensive slogans or are revealing such as miniskirts, high-cut shorts, crop tops are not acceptable. Jewellery must not be worn for any physical activity.

Please ask pupils to download the Trip Aid app for the purposes of geo-location monitoring of students and secure communication services. The academy uses this app to locate, track and monitor your child during the school trip and activities that take place off site. The academy and its teachers to use the App to communicate with your child during the active period of the school trip and its activities taking place off the academy's premises for the relevant intended purposes of location monitoring, planning and itinerary management.

Students who are not taking part in a trip should attend school as normal and will be directed into an alternative curriculum of educational activities.
