DIN activities, Diamond 9, Card sort activities, debates and class discussions Pupils will learn about the process of IVF as well as some of the advantages and disadvantages of this method of becoming pregnant. Pupils will also learn about the ways transgender people can have children that are biologically their own. They will learn about how some medication used by transgender individuals can cause fertility issues through prolonged use and how eggs and sperm can be frozen for use later.
