Year 7 Class Changes

As you are already aware, all students in Year 7 sat a series of Cognitive Ability Tests before October Half Term. This has enabled the academy to profile the year group in terms of strengths and areas for development, in lieu of SATs testing. As a result of this information, we are placing Year 7 into sets from January, which will enable teachers to pitch the content and pace of lessons at the most suitable level to meet the needs of that particular group of students. The year group will be dual-banded, so there will be two of each ability banded sets (1-4) across the year group- entitled A and C, a nod to our locality and the Aire and Calder Navigation! Year 7 students will receive new timetables and class changes will be coordinated on the first morning back in school in January.
