**RE: Options Evening (Video Presentation) w/c 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021 via your child's Google Classroom Y9 class**

Historically, in Year 8, options to study in more depth have been chosen in Year 9. However, as a school, we are responding to government guidance that it is essential for schools to strive for high standards stating ***'it can be of more benefit for students to strive for good grades in fewer subjects with a strong emphasis on doing well in English and Mathematics, than to take more subjects but achieve lower grades overall'***.

In addition, Government guidance also states that students should have access to a ***'broad and balanced curriculum for as long as possible'***.

You may therefore remember that for Year 9 students one of the main changes for September 2020 was that the Key Stage 3 curriculum will now run over three years rather than two to ensure that students secure strong foundations in a broader range of subjects.

Our curriculum pathway ensures all students have the most valuable set of qualifications to access the highest level of post-16 education and training possible in a competitive future economy. All students who leave school are now judged on their success under the following GCSE measures as they progress on to Sixth Form education, college, apprenticeship or training:

- Progress 8 – progress in their best 8 GCSEs (must include 5 from English/Maths/Science/History or Geography/Modern Foreign Language)
- Attainment 8 – best 8 GCSE pass grades (as above)
- English and Maths GCSE pass grades
- The EBacc – 5 GCSE pass grades (English, Maths, Science, History or Geography and Modern Foreign Language)

As such, students will be asked to electronically submit their options before **Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> March** using a SmartSurvey (***link will be active on the Year 9 Google classroom from the 15<sup>th</sup> March***) to make choices from the following options: -

- 1) All students will be asked to choose from a humanities subject – either History or Geography. They will continue this choice through into Year 11 where it will be an accredited GCSE subject.
- 2) If a student is taking French (qualify for the Ebacc pathway) they will take one additional option from the list below.
- 3) If a student is not taking French, they will take 2 additional options from the list below.
