<p>Key Theme: Form time: Christian Views on Creation Dropdown: The life of Jesus</p> <p>Key Concepts, Knowledge & Skills to be Embedded: Form time: Pupils will gain knowledge about the Christian beliefs surrounding the creation of the world. They will learn about the teachings of Genesis and Christian beliefs surrounding the teaching of Jesus the Messiah</p> <p>Dropdown: Pupils will be learning about the birth, life and death of Jesus. Pupils will learn about the biblical teaching surrounding the miracles Jesus performed and How and why Christians celebrate Easter including the resurrection of Jesus</p> <p>Links to Prior Learning:</p>	<p>Key Theme: Form Time: Christian Sacraments Drop Down: Morality and obeying the bible</p> <p>Key Concepts, Knowledge & Skills to be Embedded: Form Time: Pupils will learn about the sacraments within the Christian and Catholic church, they will learn what sacraments are and how and why they are important to the Christian faith.</p> <p>Dropdown: Pupils will be learning about morality including the different moral dilemmas people may have throughout life. They will also be learning about the two commandments of love God and love thy neighbour. they will also learn about the Gospels and Christians moral code</p> <p>Links to Prior Learning:</p>	<p>Key Theme: Form time: Religious Persecution Drop Down: Theories on the existence of god</p> <p>Key Concepts, Knowledge & Skills to be Embedded: Form Time: Pupils will be learning about how some people are persecuted because of their religion including the reasons why persecution happens as well as how these people have to hide their beliefs to ensure their safety</p> <p>Dropdown: Pupils will be learning about the different theories that Christians use to prove the existence of god including the theory of first cause, design and morality. They will look at the positives and negatives of each theory. They will identify and explain the theory they believe fits the existence of God the most</p> <p>Links to Prior Learning:</p>	<p>Key Theme: Form time: Forms of Worship and Prayer Drop Down: The nature of god</p> <p>Key Concepts, Knowledge & Skills to be Embedded: Form time: Pupils will be looking at the reasons why Christians worship and pray. They will be looking at the different forms of worship and the advantages and disadvantages of each of the different types of worship. .</p> <p>Dropdown: Pupils will be learning about the nature of god including the different characteristics both Christians and Muslims believe about god. They will also learn about the Christian teachings of the Holy Trinity and the Muslim teachings of Allah and the Prophet Mohammed. Pupils should the make comparisons between the two different religions beliefs around the nature of god</p> <p>Links to Prior Learning:</p>	<p>Key Theme: Form time: Origins of the earth and the value of Earth Drop Down: Religion and family life</p> <p>Key Concepts, Knowledge & Skills to be Embedded: Form Time: Pupils will learn about the different theologies surrounding the creation of the Earth including both scientific and religious views. Pupils will also learn about the religious teachings within the Islamic and Christian faith on the value of the earth including stewardship and Dominion</p> <p>Dropdown: Pupils will learn about the societal changes surrounding sex before marriage, divorce and Homosexuality.
