We also appreciate that sometimes lessons may require students to have practical resources to hand such as pens and paper. If you can let us know of any difficulties then we can see if there is a way we can help and support.

Finally, if we have made a laptop available to a member of your family so that they can take part in online lessons, **please can we ask that you discuss taking care of the laptop with your child**. We have had a significant number of devices which have been accidentally damaged over the last two weeks. If a laptop is damaged then we have to return it to the DfE (Department for Education). They are currently charging £208.29 to repair a laptop where the repair is not covered by the manufacturer's warranty. This cost would then have to be passed on to the family. I am sure you will agree that all of us would like to avoid paying this amount of money so please encourage your child, and any younger brothers and sisters, to look after the laptop, Please put it away when it is not in use and avoid walking around with it.
